



Booths

Artists provide all of their own equipment for booths, including displays, tables, chairs, and canopies if needed.

Application for a single artist booth costs \$65. Two artists may share a booth for an additional \$20.

Booth Locations

Artists may show from their own home and studio or location of their choice, or they may choose to put a booth at one of the festival stops in the village. Stop locations listed separately. Booth spaces at the village stops are available on a first come basis. Please list your home and studio address or provide a first and second choice of the village stops.

COVID-19

Chama Valley Arts is taking every precaution to ensure the safety of our vendors and patrons. We will be following best practices as recommended by the county and state at the time of the festival.

Liability

The Chama Valley Art Festival (CVAF) will not be responsible for damage to, loss, or theft of artwork, display materials, or personal belongings. Nor can CVAF be held liable for acts of terrorism or individuals committing illegal acts during the Art Festival.

Taxes

Publicity

All applicants are encouraged to send brief biographical materials and photos to be used on social media and our website. Chama Valley Arts reserves the right to use any photos or written materials for promotional purposes. Festival information is shared with media outlets throughout Northern and Central New Mexico, the Four Corners, West Texas, on social media, and on posters and banners throughout the region.

Photo/Video Release

Submission of this application gives Chama Valley Arts permission to use your image and video or audio recordings of you taken during the festival, for promotional purposes.

Donation to Raffle

CVAF requests that every artist donate an artwork (minimum value \$15) to the raffle in support of the Art Festival.

Please Read Carefully

- This is a juried festival. Your work will be reviewed anonymously by a panel for inclusion.
- Digital images of your work are preferred. They will be used for the selection process and may be used in advertising. Only images submitted digitally will be used for advertising.
- Only artwork which has been represented on your application may be displayed at the festival.
- All work must be created and produced by the exhibitor.
- Resale of commercially manufactured goods is not permitted.
- Jewelers are permitted sale of finished work only. Pre-made materials (beads, charms, etc.) cannot be sold separately; they must be incorporated into the artist's own completed designs.
- The Chama Valley Art Festival and Studio Tour reserves the right to reject any exhibitor who does not abide by this agreement.
- The Chama Valley Art Festival and Studio Tour does not collect commissions at the festival.

Deadlines and Cancellations

Artists who apply by May 27th will have an image of their work included in the brochure. After all booth spaces are filled applicants will be placed on a waiting list. Applicants on the waiting list may be asked to join if other exhibitors cancel. Cancellations made at least 2 weeks prior to the event will be refunded subject to a \$15 cancellation fee. No refunds will be issued after August 19th. No refunds will be issued due to weather.
